

Year 1 Geography Summer: *If we are not in the UK, where are we?*

We will continue to explore, “*What is my place in the world?*” by learning about the continents and oceans of the world.

Key skill: I can use maps, atlases, globes and digital resources to identify places and features.

We will be able to:

- Name and locate 7 continents and 5 oceans of the world.
- Use world maps, atlases and globes to identify continents and oceans.
- Identify the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.

To deepen our learning we will:

- Identify some of the key physical features of each continent.
- Identify some of the key human features of each continent.
- Explore the seven wonders of the world.

To celebrate our learning we will:

Create a giant world map display for others to view.

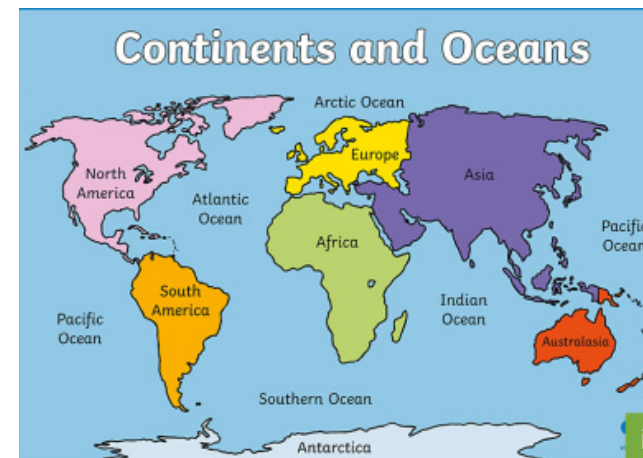
Vocabulary:

Ocean: a large area of salt water between continents.

Continent: a large, continuous area of land.

The seven continents of the world are: *Asia, South America, Africa, Europe, Antarctica, North America, Australia.*

The five oceans of the world are: *Arctic Ocean, Pacific Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Southern Ocean, Indian Ocean.*
